Children's Palliative Care Foundation (CPCF) Governing Committee

Sets strategic direction, gives advice and guidance to the CPCF for the fulfilment of its mission and advises the Board on matters relating to the effectiveness and accountability of the CPCF.

Finance, Human Resources and Remuneration Committee

Provides oversight and guidance on financial matters, human resources strategies, and staffing compensation to ensure responsible financial management, effective human capital management, and fair and transparent pay practices.

Fundraising & Development Committee

Provides advice and support in promoting CCF's public awareness and fundraising activities; and to collaborate with the Board in leading donor relationships development.

Membership & Nomination Committee

Oversees the selection and development of individuals who will serve as members of the Board or other governing committees.

Services Programme Committee

Provides advice and support in delivering comprehensive psychosocial services for paediatric patients suffering from cancer and other life-threatening chronic diseases, survivors, and bereaved families; promoting psychosocial support and education in paediatric healthcare; exploring service expansion for development.
